Chapter 5 – Park Rules and Regulations

Sec. 5.01 Parks and Recreation Areas

The District maintains open space for parks and recreation areas within the District for the benefit of the public. These parks and recreation areas are generally located on Agarita Trail and are referred to herein as the “Parks.” To ensure that everyone may enjoy these areas, the District has adopted the rules in this Chapter (the “Park Rules”).

Sec. 5.02 Park Rules

1. Park Hours: Spring/Summer 5:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. Fall/Winter 6:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
2. Alcoholic Beverages: Consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
3. Smoking: Smoking is prohibited within 50 feet of Park facilities.
4. Open Flames: No ground fires or open flames are allowed.
5. Camping: Camping is prohibited.
6. Motor-Driven Vehicles and Equipment: Except for equipment used to assist the disabled and as explicitly authorized by the District for official purposes, motor-driven vehicles and equipment are prohibited.
7. Trash and other Refuse: Littering is prohibited. All refuse must be placed in trash receptacles.
8. Control of Animals: All animals, including but not limited to dogs, cats and horses, must be under tethered control within 5 feet of its owner at all times. All pet owners must clean up after their pets.
9. Drug use: Use of illegal drugs is prohibited.
10. Firearms and Fireworks: Firearms and fireworks are prohibited.
11. Projectiles: Hurling, throwing, discharging, firing, or propelling by any means any projectile is prohibited. Under this rule, prohibited activity includes, but is not limited to, golf activities; possession or use of BB guns, pellet guns, air guns, slingshots, bows and arrows, and blowguns; and throwing or otherwise propelling stones, darts, knives, spears, and javelins. This rule does not apply to throwing balls, Frisbees, and other similar athletic objects.
12. Offensive Language: Use of offensive language is not permitted.
13. Destructive Activities: Activities that cause or are likely to cause destruction, damage, or defacement to trees or landscaping in the Parks and/or Park facilities are prohibited.
14. Harassment of Wildlife: Harassment of wildlife is prohibited.
15. Water Slides: Use of water slides in the park is prohibited.

Sec. 5.03 Penalties and Violations:

1. Violations of the Park Rules may make the person or organization in violation ineligible for future use of all Parks. Peace officers and/or an authorized representative of the District are authorized to enforce Park Rules. Depending on the severity of the offense, action taken on behalf of the District for violations of Park Rules may include one or more of the following:

- a. Notification of parents or guardian,
- b. Suspension from the Parks for an extended period of time, and
- c. Criminal and civil complaints as necessary which will include notification to the Williamson County Sheriff's Department and prosecution and/or other legal remedies.

2. Penalties. Penalties may be assessed to the individual or responsible party. Peace officers are authorized to make arrests when necessary to prevent any violation of these Park Rules. Any person who violates the Park Rules is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a penalty of up to an amount not to exceed the jurisdiction of a justice court. The District's Rules regarding appeals and violations (Chapter 6) also apply to the provisions of Chapter 5.
